ORLANDO 19 NATIONAL FINE ARTS FAQ

We've compiled some frequently asked questions to help make your time in Orlando as enjoyable and stress free as possible!

Q. CAN WE CHECK-IN WHATEVER DAY WE ARRIVE IN ORLANDO?

A. You MUST register on Tuesday at an on-site check-in between 9 am and 6 pm. You NEED to get a representative to check-in for you if you are not able to be there at that time.

Q. WHEN CAN I DROP OFF MY NON-PRESENTATION ENTRY? (ex. art, writing, film)

A. All non-scheduled entries like art, writing, film/video need to be turned in on Tuesday, July 30th.

Q. CAN I REGISTER AT ON-SITE CHECK-IN?

A. National Youth Convention registrants, Parents/Adult Chaperone registrants, and day passes may be purchased on-site. BUT we cannot guarantee a shirt or a program.

Q. DO I NEED TO BRING ANYTHING WITH ME TO NFAF ON-SITE CHECK-IN?

A. Yes. The representative checking in should have each person's confirmation email. If a participant, Fine Arts leader, or Youth Pastor did not receive a confirmation email from AGYM, please contact the NFAF office by e-mailing faf@aq.org.

Q. HOW DO I KNOW WHAT EQUIPMENT WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR MY PRESENTATIONS?

A. For presentations requiring audio, the NFAF only provides 3.5mm (1/8") audio plugs. Participants are responsible to bring a suitable device with 3.5 mm (1/8") audio jack in order to play their tracks. USB drives and CDs are not accommodated. Q. HOW DO I KNOW WHAT THE RULES AND GUIDELINES ARE FOR MY PRESENTATIONS?

A. Every year we provide an updated Rule book containing all general as well as category-specific rules and guidelines. You can find that on our website [here](#).

Q. IS THERE PARKING AT THE CONVENTION CENTER?

A. Yes! Parking at the OCCC will be \$12/day in and out privileges.

Q. WHERE CAN I FIND THE SCHEDULE FOR THE FINE ARTS PRESENTATIONS?

A. The General Schedule can be found on [Instagram](#), [Twitter](#), and [Facebook](#) and the AG Events App. As well as in the program you receive in Orlando. Upon check-in, you will receive a schedule with your individual categories as well as be able to access the schedule on the AG App.

Q. WHAT ARE PRESENTATION CALL BACKS?

A. A presentation callback is the second round of presentations for categories large enough to warrant the evaluators to watch the top-ranked presentation again. There will be no evaluator sheets give for additional rounds.

Q. WILL THERE BE CALLBACKS FOR CATAGORIES NOT LISTED ON THE SCHEDULE?

A. All callbacks are listed on the presentation schedule, if there is a category not listed then it is not planned to have a callback for the category.

Q. WHEN IS THE CELEBRATION SERVICE?

A. The celebration service this year is on Saturday, August 3rd at 7 pm!

Q. WHEN IS NATIONAL YOUTH CONVNTION?

A. National Youth Convention is in the evenings at 7 pm in Hall

Q. WHO IS LEADING WORSHIP FOR YOUTH CONVENTION?

A. South Eastern University Worship will be with us leading worship!

Q. WHAT IS THE AG EVENTS APP?

A. The AG Events app is a way to stay informed, organized, and up-to-date with the National Fine Arts and Youth Convention information! With all of the event information right at your fingertips, you can get the most from your time at Orlando19.

Q. HOW DO I DOWNLOAD THE AG EVENTS APP?

- A.*
- 1. Open the App Store app or the Google Play Store app.*
 - 2. Tap the Search icon at the bottom of your screen.*
 - 3. Type in "Assemblies of God Events" and tap Search.*
 - 4. Select the icon.*
 - 5. Tap Install and download it for free!*

Once the installation is complete, it will appear on your Home screen. Tap to open and begin using it!

Q. WILL THERE BE FINE ARTS MERCH?

A. YES! There will be Fine Arts merch sold at the AGYM booth.

Q. WHAT IS THE CODE?

A. The code is a code of conduct we put together for all attendees to understand the rules and expectations while being at #Orlando19.

Q. CAN WE BRING FOOD INTO THE CONVATION CENTER?

A. No. The Orange County Convention Center has asked that we refrain from bringing outside food into the convention center for Fine Arts and the Youth Convention services.

Q. CAN WE BRING WATER BOTTLES INTO CONVENTION CENTER?

A. Unfortunately not. Water bottles are considered outside food. HOWEVER, you can bring an empty reusable water bottle and there will be places in the OCCC that you can refill it throughout the day.

Q. WILL THERE BE FOOD FOR PURCHASE INSIDE THE CONVENTION CENTER FOR DINNER?

A. *Yes! A variety of the concession stands will stay open till 7pm so that your groups can get dinner with in the convention center between Fine Arts and Youth Convention.*
